Alexandra Basirov took on the role of Global Head of Sustainable Finance for Financial Institutions at BNP Paribas in September 2018. She was previously Head of Official Institutions coverage in the UK & Ireland, responsible for the marketing of all asset classes across product lines to Official Institutions including Central Banks, Multilaterals and Sovereign Wealth Funds in London. She joined BNP Paribas in 2006 to run the Supranational, Agency and Sovereign Debt platform across cash and derivative products and moved into OIC coverage in early 2015.

Alexandra started her career in JPMorgan's M&A department, spending time both in London and Frankfurt. She then subsequently went on to join the Debt Capital Markets team. Initially, Alexandra worked in JPMorgan's German team covering Corporates, Financial Institutions and Agencies and ultimately ran the Austrian and German financial institutions and frequent borrowers team.

She has a Bsc in Economics from the London School of Economics and during 2018/19 she completed a Positive Impact Business programme designed by the University of Cambridge Institute for Sustainability Leadership.

She has been recognised numerous times by the industry as a rising star and a leading woman in finance featuring numerous times as FN100 Most Influential Women in European Finance. In 2009, she featured as one of the 35 Women under 35 Heroines for Hard Times across industries in the UK by Management Today
