JEAN LEMIERRE

CHAIRMAN OF BNP PARIBAS

Prior to becoming Chairman of BNP Paribas on December 1, 2014, Mr. Lemierre served as Senior Advisor to the Chairman of BNP Paribas from 2008 to 2014. He is currently the Chairman of the French Center for Research Studies on the World Economy (CEPII), a member of the Institute of International Finance (IIF) and as of May 2016, a Member of the Board of Directors of TOTAL. In 2009, he became a member of both the International Advisory Council of the China Investment Corporation-CIC and the International Advisory Council of the China Development Bank-CDB.

Mr. Lemierre has had a long and distinguished career in international finance. In the 1980s, he held various posts within the French Tax Administration, including Head of Tax Legislation and Director General of Taxes. In May 1995, he was appointed Chief of Cabinet of the French Ministry of Economy and Finances and become Head of Treasury in October later that year. Before being appointed at the helm of the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development in 2000, he was a member of the European Monetary Committee (1995- 1998), President of the European Economic and Financial Committee (1999-2000) and Chairman of the Paris Club (1999-2000).

Mr. Lemierre served as President of the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development until 2008. Jean Lemierre attended the Institut d'Etudes Politiques de Paris.

He earned a degree in law and is a graduate from the Ecole Nationale d'Administration.
