Elie Lewi started in 2002 his central banker career when joining the Banque de France investment division, in charge during 5 years of managing foreign exchange reserves for Banque de France, the ECB and another Eurozone National central Bank from New York.

After working a few years for the French Market Authority (AMF) as an inspector, he was in charge, when coming back to Banque de France's dealing room, to develop and promote investment services for foreign central banks and institutions.

Since 2013, he has supervised the department in charge of financial market monitoring and analysis as well as the implementation of Asset Purchase Programs in Banque de France. A full team was dedicated to implement APP purchases, private assets (ABS, covered bonds and corporate bonds) as well as public (sovereign, agencies, supranational, regionals) and to analyze these various market segments.

Since February 2020, he's Head of Banque de France's Markets Directorate, supervising front office as well as post-trade activities for Banque de France's own financial activities and services provided to international institutions.
