Tom's core skills include project management,



sustainability strategy, leadership and culture, change and adoption, and design thinking.

Tom was previously Program Manager of the Australian Industry Energy Transitions Initiative (ETI), working with large industry and finance companies and government partners to decarbonise Australia's hard-to-abate heavy industry supply chains through defining pathways, engagement and project development. He has spent the majority of his career in technology consulting, focusing on the people and change impacts of large-scale business transformations. Before joining Climateworks, Tom led a large internal initiative to embed sustainability into the strategy and operations of a major consulting firm and build a portfolio of work to help Australian corporates achieve more sustainable outcomes across multiple sectors.

Tom has a law degree from Cambridge University as well as Scrum Master and Project Management Professional certifications, and is part of the Australian Global Talent Visa Program.
