Lynna Chandra founded the first paediatric palliative care service in Indonesia and is helping establish a palliative care ecosystem to benefit patients living with serious illnesses. Driven by the conviction that no child should ever have to live or die in pain, compassion was the underlying foundation of Rachel House and equitable access its reason for being. The outcome has been the flowering of the fountain of compassion, not just in the care that it provides, but extends far and beyond into the communities.

Lynna is now embarked on a journey in search of an equitable humane healthcare model to ensure compassionate and excellent care is available and accessible for all, in an economically sustainable way.

Lynna spent the first decade of her career in investment banking. She is an Ashoka and Atlantic Fellow, and serves on the boards of Assisi Hospice (Singapore), Common Purpose Charitable Trust (UK), and Bamboo Capital Management.
